

App Live 360 - family location sharing app:

Life360 is a free family communication, location and alert app for smartphones that allows users to share their locations with each other. Geo-fences can be used, for example, to track when family members arrive at or leave work, school or home. This may be useful for parents whose children come to and from school by themselves.







