BREAKFAST & AFTER SCHOOL CLUB (WRAPAROUND CARE):

We offer both breakfast and after school club for the children from Monday to Friday. Breakfast club runs from 7:30am-8:45am and after school club runs from 3:00pm-5:30pm. Breakfast club is £4.00 per session and after school club is £10.00 per session. In breakfast club the children have the option to have some breakfast which includes things like cereals and at after school club they are given the option to have a light tea which ranges from jacket potato to soup or pizza. App Live 360 – family location sharing app:

Life360 is a free family communication, location and alert app for smartphones that allows users to share their locations with each other. Geo-fences can be used, for example, to track when family members arrive at or leave work, school or home. This may be useful for parents whose children come to and from school by themselves.
