### **Medical and Dental appointments**

We ask that you please make every effort to avoid booking medical and dental appointments during school time. Routine dental check-up appointments should be made after school or in the holidays. If making an appointment out of school hours is not possible, your child should come to school before the appointment and return to school afterwards minimising the amount of school time missed. We do understand that specialist hospital or clinic appointments will take priority and are often during the school day.
